**VIRIDOR WASTE MANAGEMENT – PROPOSED ENERGY FROM WASTE FACILITY AT TRINITY PARK, CARDIFF.**

I refer to your e-mails sent 11<sup>th</sup> July 2008 15:29 and 17<sup>th</sup> July 2008 09:22 regarding the above proposed facility. Please note this is being dealt with as a preliminary enquiry.

It is noted that your traffic distribution suggests that 50% of the trips are in a southwesterly direction and will use the A4232 to gain access to the M4 motorway. It is assumed that these vehicles will access the A4232 south of the Culverhouse junction and not at that junction. The concern is that this junction is currently near to capacity during the AM peak and clearly any additional traffic joining it would have a detrimental effect. However, if the additional vehicles are passing through the junction on the A4232 there is not a problem.

Based on the above assumption I would advise that if a formal planning application is submitted to the local authority the Welsh Ministers would have no comments to make or objections in respect of this proposal from a transport point of view.

You should also consult with Cardiff City Council on proposals for local roads in the area.
