PREFACE

A planning application is being made by Viridor in respect of land at New England Quarry, near Lee Mill, Devon. The application contains proposals for developing a resource recovery centre which will comprise of an energy from waste facility for recovering energy from residual waste, a waste reception building, a bottom ash recycling facility for producing secondary aggregates, a non-hazardous landfill and a Visitor & Education Centre.

Volume 1 comprises the planning application, including a supporting statement, application forms and certificates.

Volume 2 includes all application drawings including building details, access roads, landfill phasing and landscape proposals;

Volumes 3a to 3c contains the Environmental Statement, which reports on the Environmental Impact Assessment that has been undertaken to assess the environmental effects of the development proposals, and any residual effects following the introduction of measures to mitigate these predicted impacts. All Technical Appendices and associated Technical drawings are also included.

Volume 4 contains the Non Technical Summary which reviews the results of the EIA in a format that excludes, wherever possible, the use of technical language.

The documents have been prepared by SLR Consulting Ltd except for the Statement of Community Involvement, which has been prepared by 3Monkeys Communications.
